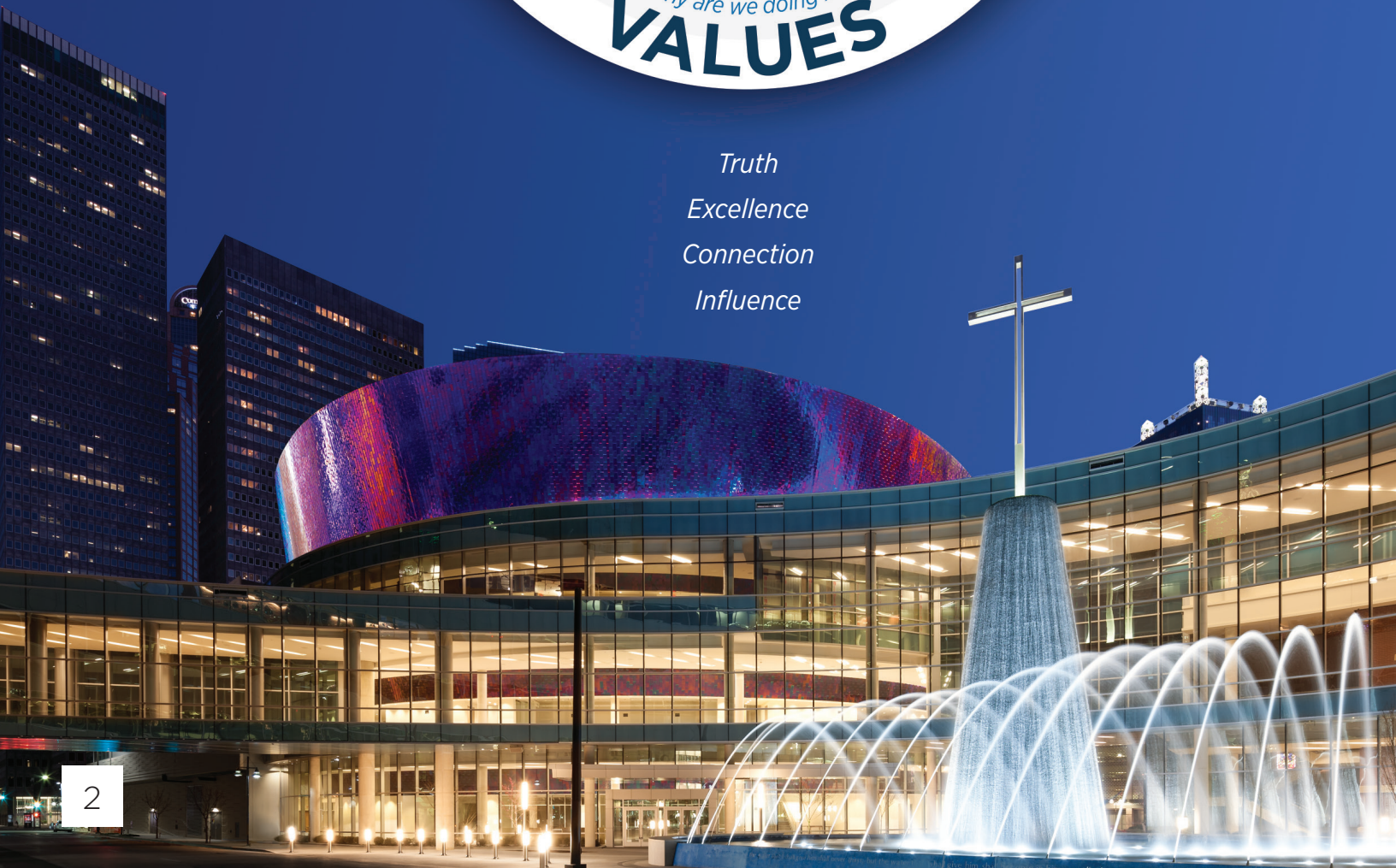

Founding Dean of Criswell College, he most recently served as Distinguished Senior Professor of Pastoral Theology. He was an accomplished author as well as writing numerous publications. His most recent book, *The New Guidebook for Pastors*, is currently used in seminaries, colleges and churches across the country.

Dr. Bryant is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Ruby, two sons, and two grandchildren.
